RAMELIUS COMMENCES ADDITIONAL RESOURCE DRILLING AT BLACK CAT PROJECT

Ramelius Resources Limited has commenced an Aircore drilling programme of approximately 1600m over 28 holes at the Black Cat project 35 km north of Coolgardie in Western Australia. Late last year the Company outlined a total resource of 250,000 @ 2.7g/t gold at Black Cat South (**approximately 21,700 oz of gold**) comprised of 200,000 tonnes @ 2.7g/t gold [Indicated] and 50,000 tonnes @ 2.6g/t gold [Inferred]

The aim of this current drilling program is to outline additional resources along the Black Cat trend. The main target zones are at depths of 20 to 45 m and are listed below;

- The up-dip portion of the Black Cat South deposit and the immediate strike extent to the east and west towards the Black Cat Open Pit.
- North of and up-dip from the Black Cat Open Pit where the flitch plans from the previous mining operation show that potentially economic gold mineralisation was left in the north-eastern wall.
- Up to 200m west of the Black Cat Open Pit where previous wide spaced drilling has indicated gold mineralisation along the trend of the known gold mineralisation.
